What?

When?

24th to 29th July 2019

For who?

For all girls, boys, adolescents & young adults until 29 year, and their groupleaders. Children under 10 years of age can participate with their families.

Participants register normally as groups with their own leaders. Young leaders & adults can attend on their own.

How?

Camping in tents by the lake Salvonen in five camp villages: Purola, Kumpula, Järvelä, Savula and Harjula. Programme will be held partly in the villages, partly as a whole camp.

Everything happens outdoors; accommodation in participants' own tents.

Dining shelters and toilets are present in the villages
Common meals are served & included in the price

130 euros / person + travel expences (siblings 120€). You can ask your own organisation or parish to give you financial aid.
